

WHITEFISH LAKE GOLF CLUB AGE RESTRICTION ON THE GOLF COURSE

The Whitefish Lake Golf Club has always been a leader in the promotion of Junior Golf. We accept, promote, and encourage junior golfers starting at a young age.

Junior Golfers are allowed on the golf course, as players, provided:

- 1. They are members (or pay a green fee)
- 2. They have their own clubs
- 3. They can keep up with the pace of play
- 4. They understand the etiquette of the game
- 5. They exercise safety on the course

Juniors may be asked to be certified by the Golf Professional staff before playing on the course.

All non-playing children on the course must:

- 1. Be at least six years old
- 2. Be supervised by an adult
- 3. Understand the etiquette of golf
- 4. Respect the course
- 5. Remain relatively quiet

The supervising adult assumes all responsibility and liability for children under their care.

The purpose of this is to inform all passholders and guests of our policy regarding children, especially toddlers and infants. Due to the danger of errant golf balls and the inherent risk associated with golf in general, we DO NOT allow non-playing children under the age of six on the golf course.
