Tee Time Cancellation Policy  
2025

Accountability of unused tee times is long overdue therefore we have established the following tee time cancellation policy for 2025.

- Cancellation is required for any unused tee time
  - Tee times MUST be cancelled 24 hours in advance
  - Failure to cancel times will result in loss of tee time privileges and/or fines
    - First offense – warning
    - Second offense - \$100 fine
    - Third offense - \$100 fine and loss of tee time privileges
    - Fourth offense – Loss of playing privileges
      - Requires meeting with BOD for reinstatement
- Day of play modifications will also result in fines and loss of privileges
  - A foursome turns into a twosome without 24-hour notice to the starter
  - Two tee times are booked and only one tee time is needed on the day of play
- We are a busy golf course and need to utilize tee times efficiently
  - A foursome which turns into a threesome must notify the starter 30 minutes prior to tee time to allow walk-on singles to be paired
  - Twosomes will be paired with twosomes when needed
- Day of play check-in procedures – All names are required on the tee sheet
  - Check in with starter 20 minutes prior to tee time

- Players can add names to the tee sheet via:
  - Informing starter day of play 20 minutes prior to teeing off
  - Thru the member portal prior to arrival at course
  - Phone the starter on day of play with all names
  
- Inclement weather – We understand there will be days where weather is a factor. Cancellation at the last hour will happen as we wait for storms to come and go. Common sense will prevail when waiting out a storm to see if playing is an option.
